

COVID RESPONSE


There have been three national lockdowns in the UK during which time there was remote learning and reduced lesson times to allow for longer breaks away from the computer screen.

- 16 March-1 Sept 2020, Southbank students were taught remotely
- September-December 2020 there was a mixture of face to face and virtual teaching
- 6 January-8 March 2021 students were again taught remotely
- · During remote learning all sporting clubs and Extracurricular Activities were cancelled
- From March 2020 onwards many SATs and ACTs were cancelled in the UK, providing very limited opportunities to take the tests
