## OUR CURRICULUM

Southbank is a non-selective IB World Continuum School (3 - 18) with three campuses in central London. The school offers an educational experience focused on the internationally recognized International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years and Diploma Program which leads to qualification at level 3 within the UK National Qualifications Framework.

Our student body comprises a vibrant community of learners, with an enrollment of 168 students in the IB Diploma, and 343 in the Middle Years Program. Our students bring a wide range of international experiences, having lived in multiple countries and gained exposure to various curricular programs. While 27% of our students are UK nationals, the remainder comes from diverse backgrounds.

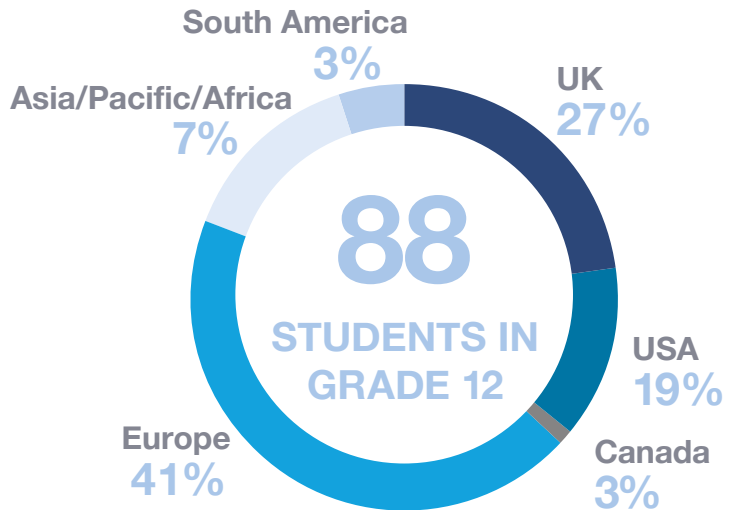

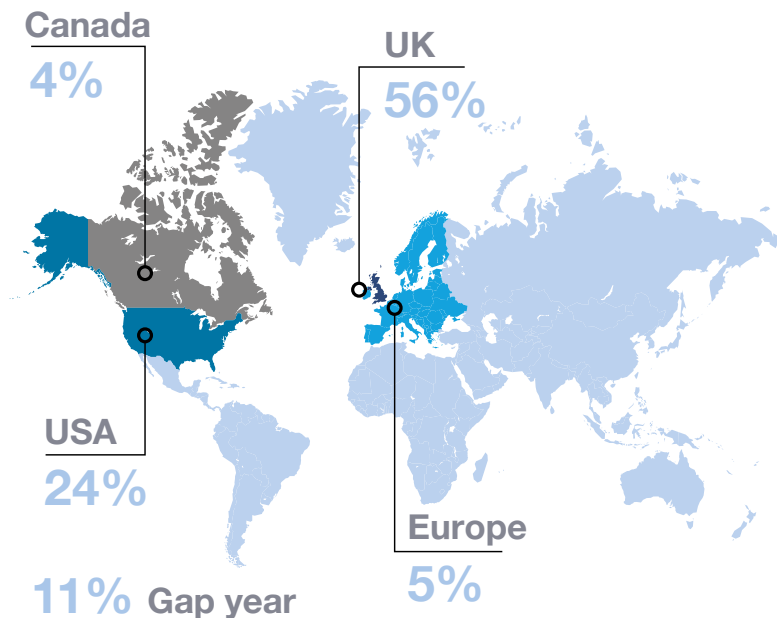
