

OUR CURRICULUM

Southbank is a non-selective IB World Continuum School (3-18) with three campuses in central London. The school offers an educational experience focused on the internationally recognized International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years and Diploma Program which leads to qualification at level 3 within the UK National Qualifications Framework.

Our student body comprises a vibrant community of learners, with an enrollment of 165 students in the IB Diploma, and 295 in the Middle Years Program. Our students bring a wide range of international experiences, having lived in multiple countries and gained exposure to various curricular programs. While 23% of our students are UK nationals, the remainder comes from diverse backgrounds.




IB MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME

The IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) at Southbank serves as the curriculum framework for students in Grades 6 to 10. It encompasses eight subject groups, fostering learning through interdisciplinary units at each grade level. Service in Action is also a core component of the programme, emphasising practical engagement in learning.

Accredited by Ofqual as a distinguished educational framework, the MYP stands alongside other prestigious programmes like the IGCSE. A cornerstone of the final year in the MYP is the Personal Project, an extensive, student-led inquiry that spans nine months. Students choose their own topic and develop their projects with guidance, culminating in reflective reports based on their process journals. These reports are externally moderated to ensure quality and consistency. In the 2024-2025 academic year, the average score from 73 Grade 10 students was 4.5 on a scale of 1 to 7.

Grade 10 students also sit the IB MYP eAssessments in Mathematics, English, and the Interdisciplinary Learning component. These externally marked onscreen examinations assess both subject-specific knowledge and the students' ability to integrate and apply their understanding in authentic contexts.

ADVISORY

At Southbank, every student is paired with an advisor who supports them in reaching their personal and academic goals. The advisor serves as both a teacher and mentor, fostering a supportive environment where students feel connected and engaged with their school community. Advisory sessions provide a sense of belonging and nurture student relationships, covering topics critical to student well-being and promoting a culture of care and safety. Students gather for advisory meetings each morning and convene once a week for extended sessions.
